



How much is my case worth?

I hate to give the typical lawyer answer but "it depends" on a few major factors.

The value of your claim will be driven by a combination of the following:

Severity of your injuries

How injured were you in your accident? Generally, the more severe the injury, the more the case is worth.

Liability

Who was at fault for the accident? If the other side has admitted liability, the case usually has more value. If liability is at issue, meaning it is disputed who was at fault, the value could potentially be less.

Work loss

Did you miss work due to your injury? That work loss is able to be recovered in many injury claims.

Insurance coverage

Did the at fault party have adequate insurance to cover your injuries? If so, the claim is easier to pursue.

Trial forum

Certain jurisdictions are better to try certain types of cases.
